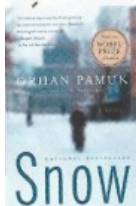

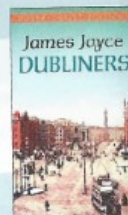

SNOW Orhan Pamuk

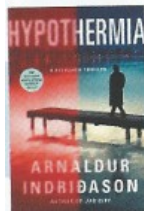

15 short stories of Dublin small life but of universal interest, recalling the city's paralysis and Joyce's need to escape from it.



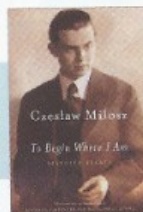
HYPOTERMIA Arnaldur Indriðason

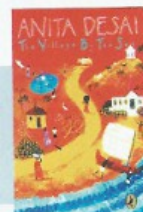
TO BEGIN WHERE I AM Czeslaw Milosz
